- Nominations closed September 8th at 5:00 pm.






Qualifications

- A candidate must have been a member of UTLA for at least 24 months.
- Only Early Ed Teachers are qualified to run
- Only Early Ed Teachers will be voting.







Why is this Election Important?

- The EE Director is your voice on the UTLA Board of Directors (BOD)
- The BOD votes whether to approve important policy decisions & they must approve TA's before they are sent to the membership
- The Special Directors are called in for contract negotiations related to the group they represent



UTLA Board of Directors

- There are eight UTLA Areas --4 representatives for each
 - North, South, East, West, Central, Harbor, Valley East and Valley West.
- You all work in one of these areas- your 4 Area Directors are your representatives.
- However, Early Ed Teachers also have a Special Director to represent their specific issues
- Only 6 groups are identified in the UTLA Constitution to have a Special Director position representing their specific group of members

UTLA Special Directors –Citywide Representatives

Only these groups have a special director to represent and advocate for them at the UTLA Board of Directors

- Adult Education
- Early Education
- Special Education
- Bilingual Education
- Substitute Teachers
- Health and Human Social Work Professionals



Duties of the Early Ed Director

The Early Ed Director will:

- Attend the EE Committee meeting and help lead with the EE Committee Chair
- Be available to All Early Ed Teachers by providing contact information
- Work with your UTLA Area Rep., Pablo Murillo, to address school site issues
- Represent Early Ed teachers interests on the UTLA BOD.

The UTLA Early Ed Director is your only <u>political representative focused on Early Ed issues</u> in the UTLA Governance structure.



Importance of High Voter Turnout

- High voter turnout demonstrates your engagement and will be a strong mandate for whomever is elected
- This is a great opportunity to connect with the candidates and develop a relationship – so the issues you care about will be heard by the UTLA BOD
- Conducting this election is expensive so it should be taken very seriously

How will we vote?

- Your ballot will be mailed to your home.
- You can mail in your ballot or use your 8-digit PIN which comes with your ballot to vote online. You will also need to put in your employee #
- If UTLA does not have your correct current address the ballot will not be forwarded. Please update your address now at https://www.utla.net/members/update-your-information
- If you don't get a ballot, fill out the Replacement Ballot/ PIN Request form at **utlaelections.org** and you will have the choice to receive a paper ballot if you request it by Dec. 14th or you may have your PIN emailed to you so you can vote online.

- Online Directions- if you had problems before...don't worry
 - Voters will no longer need to add zeros to their employee number if it has fewer than 8 digits
 - Everyone should be able to vote electronically this if they want to.

 - If you can't find your ballot or didn't receive one, fill out the Replacement Ballot and PIN Request Form and request your PIN.



January 7: **DEADLINE** for candidates to submit an Observer Request Form – received by 5:00 p.m.

January 11: **DEADLINE** for paper and electronic ballots to be received by 8:00 a.m.



January 11: Elections Committee Observes Ballot Count via ZOOM. Candidates or their identified Observer may also observe if the Candidate has submitted the Observer Request Form by 1/07/2021 5:00 p.m.
