

What is a General Election

- Every 3 years UTLA members elect the Officers and Members of the Board of Directors.
- Everyone will have the officer elections on their ballot.
- If you work at a single site, and your cost code is the school, you will automatically also be able to vote for your local Area Directors.
- If you work at more than one site, or you are an HHS professional with a different cost code, then fill out the https://utlaelections.org/information/itinerant-assignments-declaration-form/. If you don't fill this out, you will not be able to vote for your Area Directors. The deadline for voters who are itinerants is December 16, 2022.

If you work at more than site...

- If you work at multiple sites fill out the **Itinerant** Assignments Declaration Form.
- You will be assigned to an area where you work 50% or more of the time.
- If you don't fill this form out, you will only be able to vote for officers and a special category if you qualify

UTLA Board of Directors

- There are eight UTLA Areas: North, South, East, West, Central,
 Harbor, Valley East, and Valley West.
- Each Area has 4 directors, 3 represent NEA and 1 represents AFT.
- Your 4 Area Directors are your representatives on the Board of Directors. They also help with local issues and work with Chapters Chairs at schools in your area.

What do NEA and AFT stand for?

- NEA is the National Education Association and AFT is the American Federation of Teachers. They are the two national teachers' unions.
- We are also under the two state affiliates the California Teachers Association (CTA) which is the state affiliate of NEA and the California Federation of Teachers (CFT) which is the state affiliate of AFT.

Aren't we a merged union now, aren't all of us members of AFT and NEA?

- UTLA is merged but AFT and NEA are not merged.
- All UTLA members of both national unions and their state affiliate CFT and CTA but as an organization, UTLA has contracts and obligations with both organizations.
- If and until there is a merger of AFT and NEA, UTLA will continue to have AFT and NEA Vice Presidents and AFT and NEA members of the Board of Directors.
- The agreement is that there are three NEA members and one AFT member for each UTLA Area.



Are you a member in a Special Category?

- There are 6 kinds groups of members who qualify to vote for a Special Category Member of the Board of Directors. They are citywide representatives.
- You may qualify to vote for one or more of these directors if you are

A Special Education Teacher
An Adult Education Teacher
An Early Childhood Center Teacher
A Substitute Teacher
A Health and Human Services Professional or
Have a Bilingual Authorization such as BCLAD or equivalent.

Some Elections May be Unopposed

• If your area only has 3 NEA director candidates and 1 AFT director condition, they are elected by acclamation.

• If some of your directors were unopposed, those Area race will not appear on your ballot.

• If there is only one candidate for a special director, they are elected by acclamation and will not appear on your ballot.



Qualifications to Vote

- In order to vote you must be a dues paying member the month before ballots become available.
- The election company qualified voters a PIN to the email address UTLA has on file.
- Update your email address now for easy access to voting. https://utla.net/resources/update-your-contact-information/





What is a PIN? Why do I need it?

- A Personal Identification Number (PIN) is a number an organization uses to make sure that only you can access information.
- All voting will be online. You will need your PIN to vote.
- Your PIN assigned to each voter is unique to this election only.
- The election company assigns a 7-digit PIN to each eligible voter for each election. UTLA does not create or have access to your PIN.
- The voting company will email you your PIN using the non-LAUSD email address that UTLA has on file.



How will we vote?

- There will not be paper ballots. The election company will email you a PIN using the email UTLA has on file. Make sure UTLA has your current non- LAUSD email address.
- Check the Timeline. https://utlaelections.org/information/election-timeline/
- If you don't get an email with your PIN first check your Spam folder.
- If you do not receive an email, you can also easily access your ballot with the email through the election company's **FIND MY PIN** on their website.
- You will put in the last four digits of your SS# and your employee number and can access your PIN and your ballot automatically. The link to the Election Company will be on the utlaelections.org website.

Find My PIN

- Using the PIN provided in the email from the Election Company is an alternative way to access your ballot.
- Find My PIN allows you to access your PIN if you don't receive or can't find the email. It makes voting online easier than ever.
- The UTLA Elections Committee will support you with any issues you have with the voting process. info@utlaelections.org



Find my PIN (Personal Identification Number)

- Some of you may have used in UTLA contract votes.
- It's an automatic way for members to access their PIN online to vote online.
- To use Find my PIN, you will put in your employee number and the last 4 numbers of your Social Security number.
- Find My PIN will provide your PIN and a link to the login page.
- From there you enter your employee number and your PIN and access your ballot.



If there are problems

- If you worked in December and you didn't get an email and you cannot get your PIN using the Find My PIN system, email us immediately at info@utlaelections.org
- If you did <u>not</u> pay dues in December before the election, you may <u>not</u> receive an email and Find My PIN may not work for you.
- If you work in January and pay dues, we will update the list on "Find My PIN" by the second week of February. You will still have plenty of be able to vote online. However, stay in contact with the Elections Committee.



- This is a great opportunity to connect with the candidates and develop a relationship so the issues you care about will be heard by the UTLA Officers and BOD members.

How can we learn about the candidates?


- Candidates will have Chapter Chairs' contact info
 - Candidates may ask Chap. Chairs to email flyers to their members.
 - Candidates may request to speak at a chapter meeting
 - You should not get a phone call or email from a candidate unless you explicitly give the candidate permission.
- Members can contact the candidate- (Candidate emails will be online)
 - Ask your Chapter Chair to invite the candidates to speak at your chapter meeting
 - All members can email candidates with questions, concerns or just to introduce themselves
