Improve standard of living for teachers and campus presentation

- Increases wages commensurate to our degrees and index wages to yearly inflation.
- Prioritize funding by stopping LAUSD hoarding and demanding more from Sacramento and D.C.
- Restore custodial & clerical services to pre-recession levels to make our schools beautiful, clean, accessible parts of our communities.
- 3 months paid maternity leave for new parents.

PEDAGOGY

Develop the science and art of teaching

- Class sizes must be reasonable in all subjects and grade levels.
- Invest in teacher training and support including release days for planning curriculum.
- Community generated curriculum that is relevant to the daily lives of our students and based on inquiry, including arts and technical education.
- Reduce reliance on school police and hire more psychologist and counselors.
- A progressive evaluation system that provides real support and prioritizes students learning.
